- 1. <u>Product Rules</u>: Individual dealers/vendors may not prepare food or beverages on site. Food trailers and a concession stand will be open to the public. The sale of "Farm Fresh" products, such as eggs, requires a permit through the Greenbrier County Health Department. Knives, antique guns, muzzleloaders, bb guns, and airsoft guns are permitted. ANY OTHER WEAPONS OR COUNTERFEIT ITEMS ARENOT PERMITTED.
- 2. Spaces: All space measurements are approximate. Due to layout of terrain and equipment, sizes will marginally vary.
- 3. <u>ALL VENDORS HAVE TO SIGN UP FOR ALL DAYS AND PAY AT THE TIME OF SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION:</u> Requests for a particular space may be included with this form and received in the office with payment by Aug 2.
- 4. Returning Spring Vendors Applying before Early Bird deadline will have priority to their spots at the previous Flea Market. After Aug 2nd spaces will be assigned by the SFWV Staff.
- 5. <u>SET UP TIME</u>: All vendors may set upon Wednesday, Sept. 4th and Thursday, Sept. 5th between 9AM-8PM
- 6. WE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING IN OFFICE APPLICATIONS AUGUST 3RD AUGUST 20TH
- 7. <u>TEARDOWN TIME</u>: All vendors are asked to stay open until 3 PM on Sunday, Sept.8th, encouraged to be off the grounds by 8PM on Sunday Sept. 8th. ANY ITEMS AND/OR TRASH LEFT WILL RESULT IN A \$150 CLEANUP FEE AND THE GROUP OR INDIVIDUAL WILL NOT

BE PERMITTED TO RETURN AS A VENDOR.
